
How to get there

The Passive House Basics Course takes place at Großer Hörsaal, Hörsaaltrackt, Baufakultät,

Technikerstraße 21, University of Innsbruck, A-6020 Innsbruck.

Via public transport:

From the Central Station (Innsbruck Hauptbahnhof), take bus R (direction Rehgasse) or bus F (direction Flughafen). Get off at "Klinik/Universität". Change here to bus O (direction Technik West/Peerhofsiedlung or Allerheiligen). Get off at "Technik".

From this bus stop (see map), it is a short walk to Technikerstraße 21. Pass the blue building "Europaheim", on the opposite side of the road. Turn left and then walk straight until you see the "Hörsaaltrakt" building. The course takes place in the "Großer Hörsaal" auditorium.

From the Innsbruck airport, take bus F to "Fürstenweg". Change to bus O (direction Technik West/Peerhofsiedlung or Allerheiligen). Get off at "Technik". You may also take a taxi (approx. 10 minutes).
