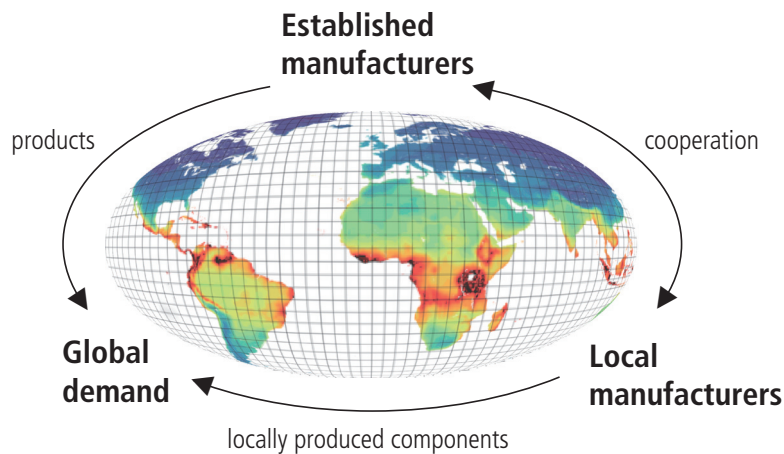

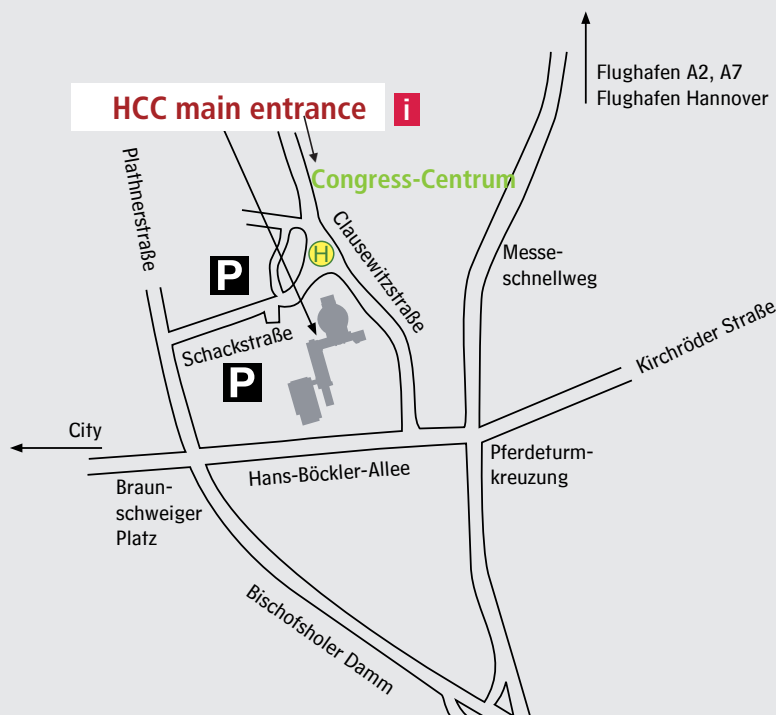
## 16 INTERNATIONAL PASSIVE HOUSE CONFERENCE 2012
